

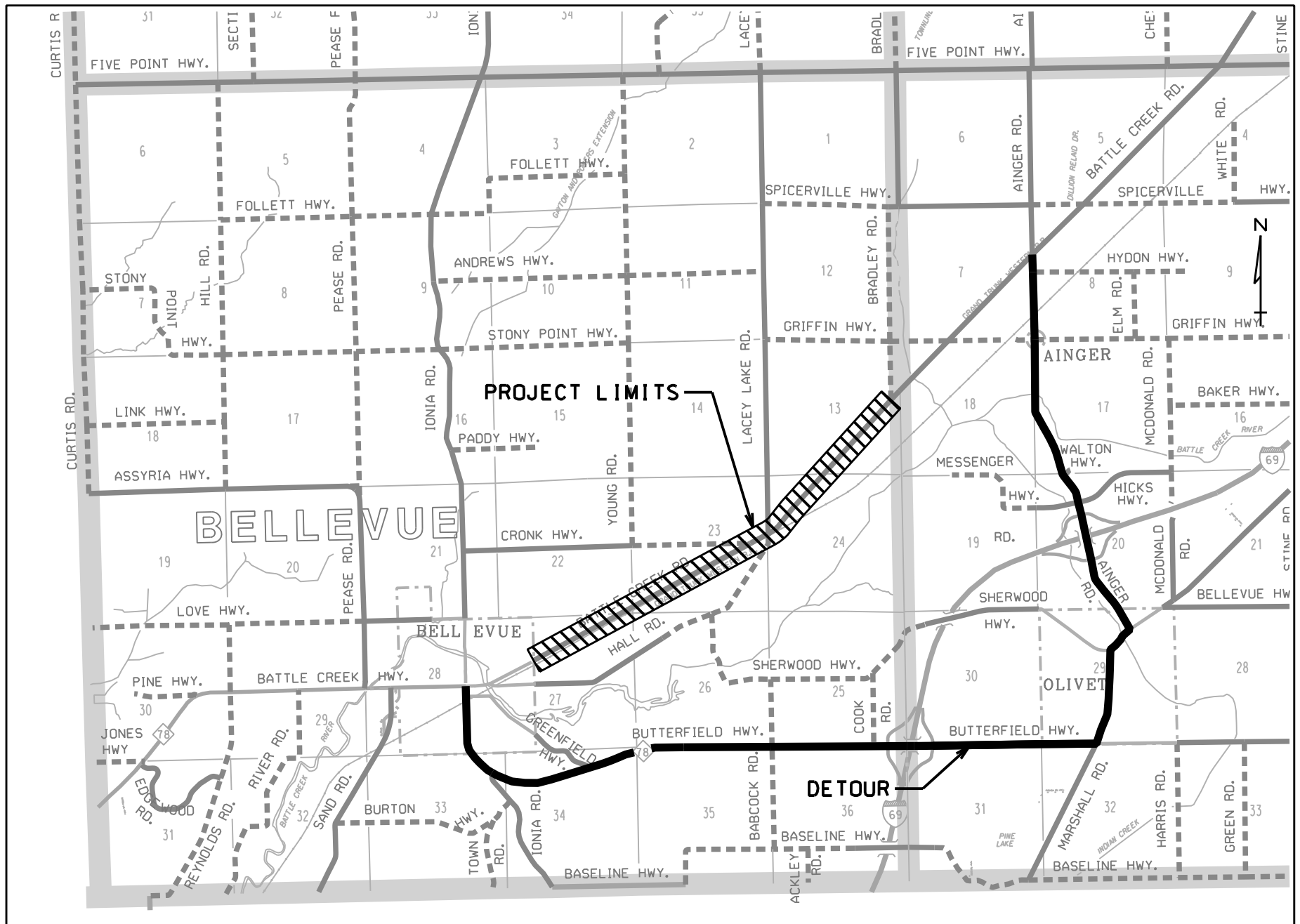
The MDOT **will** advertise our Battle Creek Road rehabilitation and reconstruction project to open bids Friday, August 5. This project will rehabilitate and resurface 3.4 miles of Battle Creek Road from Bradley Road to the Village limits of Bellevue, and will complete the final segment of a nearly 11 mile of County Primary road improvement project from Charlotte to Bellevue that began in 2019.

Work on the project will include extensive repairs to the concrete road base, drainage and culvert replacements, intersection widening with curb and gutter, and full width repaving providing 4 foot paved shoulders. During much of the construction the road will be closed only to through traffic and a detour will be signed, but local traffic access to residences and businesses on the road will be maintained.

Work on the project is expected to begin this fall, with final paving and completion by August 1, 2023.

Over 98% of the estimated \$1,384,000 construction cost on the project will be paid by state and federal grants allocated to Eaton County through the Michigan Department of Transportation.
