A regular meeting of the Eaton County Board of Road Commissioners was held at their office in Charlotte, Michigan on November 10, 2015.

Moved by Eldred, second by Tennis to approve gift cards for employee gifts to be distributed at the annual employee holiday breakfast. Motion carried.

Mr. Parshall reported on the activities of the road crews. There was discussion.
