

Sand Road – County line to M-78

Updated: May 19, 2021

Expected Start Date: May 20, 2021

Expected Completion Date: Mid-July

Township: Bellevue

Description: Sand Road is scheduled to be rehabilitated beginning on May 20, 2021. Work will include trenching along each side of the road, placing gravel across the entire road width, crushing and shaping the existing pavement, and paving 30 feet wide with gravel shoulders. Work is expected to take no more than two months.

During the project, the road will be closed to thru traffic. There may be short times when culverts are removed or equipment is blocking the road when access will only be possible from one direction. Other than short periods when work is occurring immediately at a driveway, driveway access will be maintained. Your patience is appreciated as we work to improve these 1.7 miles of road.

Mailboxes will be temporarily removed during this project and placed in each yard. Mail service will be maintained using temporary mailboxes placed at each address. After all work is complete, mailboxes will be reinstalled in the original location.

Trash service will be maintained during the project. Residents can continue to follow the current trash disposal process.
