

INTRODUCTION

The Eaton County Road Commission was established in 1912 by resolution of the County Board of Supervisors and charged by law with the duty "to keep in reasonable repair, so that they shall be reasonably safe and convenient for public travel, all county roads, bridges, and culverts that are under their care and control, and which are open to public travel." State law also requires the Road Commission to permit and regulate certain activities in road right-of-way, authorizes the Road Commission to set reasonable standards for adopting new roads into the county system and to enforce state restrictions on vehicle size and weight on county roads.

Over the past 108 years, the Eaton County road system has grown to include over 391 miles that are now designated as Primary roads. Passage of the McNitt Act in 1931 abolished the old township road system and transferred over 650 miles of township roads to the Road Commission. These old township roads, together with over 120 miles of subdivision streets built since that time, make up what is now the nearly 783-mile system of County Local roads. Overall, 57%, or 676 miles, of all Eaton County roads are paved, with the remaining 500 miles being gravel surfaced but otherwise unimproved.

Routine maintenance by Road Commission workers is organized into four service areas. Crews working in the southeast and southwest areas of the County operate out of the main garage in Charlotte. The northwest quarter of the County is served by the crew based in Vermontville, and the northeast area covered by workers from our garage in Delta Township.

While the Road Commission continues to use its own forces for emergency and minor repairs, and most of the routine maintenance of snow removal, gravel blading and seal coating, all road and bridge construction and most other heavy maintenance work is performed by private contractors selected through competitive bids. Many other routine maintenance operations that require specialized equipment such as mowing, pavement markings and street sweeping are also provided by private firms. The dollar amount contracted with private companies in fiscal year 2018-2019 equaled 63% of the total expenditures for road maintenance and construction.

On Primary roads in 2019, the Road Commission was able to use \$1,571,000 of state TEDF and federal RSTP grant funds to make base repairs, construct paved shoulders, intersection and drainage improvements, and repave 4.4 miles of Battle Creek Road from Carlisle Highway to Five Point Highway in Carmel Township as the first part of a multi-year plan to rehabilitate and repave

that roadway between the Village of Bellevue and the City of Charlotte. In partnership with Delta Township, the Road Commission was able to utilize \$625,000 in federal USTP grant funds to rehabilitate the road base, repair drainage, repair curb and gutter, and repave .75 miles of Mall Drive West from M-43 to Elmwood Road. Delta Charter Township contributed \$110,000 of the local match funds required by that grant, and also provided all the local funds necessary to use \$520,000 of federal TAP grant funds to construct bicycle lanes on Old Lansing Road from Waverly Road to Lansing Road (business I-69). Across the county the Road Commission was able to use the increased funding available again in 2019 from the Michigan Transportation Fund (MTF) to resurface an additional 41 miles of primary roads using hot mix asphalt, and also placed a new sealcoat surface with fog seal on an additional 40 miles Primary roads.

While no Primary Road Bridges were replaced in 2019, we were able to replace a large culvert on Benton Road over the Johnson drain with the cooperation with the Drain Commission and replaced several other crossroad culverts as needed on the asphalt resurfacing projects throughout the county.

On Local Roads, 2019 marked the 5th year of the 12-year road rehabilitation program funded by the county-wide road millage. The Road Commission repaired and resurfaced 24 miles of paved Local Roads and re-graded and re-graveled 30 miles of unimproved Local Roads using millage funds supplemented with state MTF revenue. Due to a labor dispute involving a local paving company contracted for the work, 5 miles of resurfacing work on subdivision streets in the 2019 millage program were not completed. We anticipate that those projects will be completed this year in addition to the planned 2020 millage program. While all completed millage program projects are noted in the following pages, a supplemental multi-year report regarding the millage program projects with supporting information is available separately.


No Local road bridges were replaced in 2019, but several crossroad culverts were replaced in conjunction with the millage-funded local road resurfacing projects or as requested through cost sharing agreements with Township boards as noted elsewhere in this report.

While the Road Commission's first priority is public safety on all county roads, we continue to utilize state Asset Management principals in working towards keeping the existing good roads in Eaton County in good condition, rather than deferring timely maintenance on those roads in order to pay for the improvement and/or construction of new paved roads.

Recognizing the need for long range planning for improvements on the county road system, the Road Commission participates in the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission planning process,


and actively seeks and competes for federal and state grant funds and other local government funds for specific improvement projects whenever possible.


