The Board of Eaton County Road Commissioners has advertised for bids to be received at 1112 Reynolds Road, Charlotte, Michigan 48813, until 10:00 A.M, Monday February 21, 2020 at which time and place bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for furnishing and delivering the following materials:

Seasonal requirements of Seal Coat Aggregates of various gradations as shown on the bid blank and delivered to Road Commission Garages and other locations throughout Eaton County as indicated on the bid blank.

All proposals must be prepared on the bid blanks attached and must be sealed in an envelope that is plainly marked as to the material being bid.

The Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids, or part of the same, and make the award in part or entirely that in the opinion of the Board is in the best interest of Eaton County Road Commission and the County of Eaton, Michigan.

Following the bid opening, the bids will be reviewed by staff to determine recommendations to the County Board of Road Commissioners on their next regular meeting date. During this time period the bids are closed and information regarding the bids is not available.

MATERIALS

All materials shall meet the requirements of the Michigan Department of Transportation 2012 Standard Specifications for Construction and as described herein:

Aggregate 28B- Modified shall meet the following gradation:

Sieve size	% Passing
½"	100
3/8"	95-100
No. 4	0-20
No. 8	0-5
Loss by wash	maximum 3.0%
Minimum crush content	- none

Aggregate 34CS-Modified shall have a minimum crush content of 70%

The Eaton County Road Commission will sample all material at both the production site and delivery point and test same. Any material not meeting these specifications shall not be delivered and will be rejected the site of delivery.

SEALCOAT AGGREGATE

The bidder may choose to obtain sealcoat aggregate 28B-Modified, 29A, or 34CS-Modified, from more than one source. However, material delivered to each separate location must be from the same source and of consistent gradation. Mixing aggregates from different sources or of different gradations into the same stockpile will not be permitted.

Stockpile locations of seal coat material may vary within the individual quadrants specified on Bid Sheet to facilitate sealcoat operations.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. All shipments must be accompanied by a load ticket to be presented to the inspector upon delivery of material. The load ticket must state location of delivery.
2. Eaton County Road Commission reserves the right to weigh, at random, material being delivered for verification weight at no charge to the Road Commission.
3. The Road Commission reserves the right to assign haul routes for delivery.
4. The contractor shall restore, at his own expense, any public or private property damaged or injured in consequence of any act or omission on his part or on the part of his employees or agents, to a condition similar and equal to that existing before such damage or injury was done. If the contractor neglects to repair or make restoration, the engineer may after 48 hours-notice to the contractor, proceed to make such repairs or restorations, and will deduct the cost thereof from any monies that are or may become due to the contractor.
5. The contractor will be responsible for all vehicles that are used in this operation and all penalties imposed for violations of the haul route procedure.
6. Drivers of trucks are expected to use and exercise care while on this project. Excessive speed and/or carelessness will not be tolerated by the Road Commission. Instances of the above will be brought to the attention of the successful bidder. Continuing instances will lead to the request to remove the driver from haul and may lead to termination of the contract.
7. The Road Commission may award bids in whole or parts thereof, and reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, waive irregularities in any bid and make award in any manner deemed for the best interest of the County.

8. The contractor agrees that he will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment, to be employed in the performance of this contract with respect to his/her hire, tenure, terms, conditions, or privileges of employment or any matter directly or indirectly related to employment because of his/her age, race, color, religion, natural origin or ancestry in compliance with State and Federal Law.
9. Trucks hauling loads designated for Eaton County road projects and/or Eaton County must meet legal loading limitations. Load tickets will be checked and trucks in violation may receive citations as well as the load being rejected.
10. All deliveries to stockpiles must be coordinated with the superintendent or his designate prior to shipment. Delivery of approximately 3,800 tons will be required prior to June 1, 2021, with additional quantities through the late summer/fall as may be required to fill all designated stockpile locations.
11. All bid prices shall remain firm through November 30, 2022. The contract may be extended for one year until November 30, 2022 upon the mutual agreement of both parties.

DAMAGE LIABILITY & INSURANCE

The contractor shall provide adequate insurance coverage and will provide the Eaton County Road Commission with a certificate of insurance satisfactory to the Board. The contractor shall save harmless of The Eaton County Road Commission and its Employees against all claims for damages to public or private property for injuries arising out of and during the progress of the work and to the completion of the work. Contractor shall meet the insurance requirement set forth in Section 1.07.10 of the Michigan Department of Transportation 2012 Standard Specifications for Construction.
