EATON COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION FEBRUARY 13, 2018

A regular meeting of the Eaton County Board of Road Commissioners was held at their office in Charlotte, Michigan on February 13, 2018.

Members Present: Commissioners Eldred, Lamoreaux, Frazier, Lyons, Maxwell

Members Absent: none

Chair Eldred called the meeting to order at 8:35 am.

Moved by Lyons, second by Lamoreaux, that the agenda be approved as printed. Motion carried.

Moved by Maxwell, second by Frazier, that the minutes of January 23, 2018 be approved as printed. Motion carried.

There was no public comment.

Moved by Frazier, second by Lamoreaux, that Accounts Payable (VO#29) of 01-25-18 in the amount of \$134,921.92, Accounts Payable (VO#30) of 02-01-18 in the amount of \$58,809.59, Payroll (VO#31) of 02-07-18 in the amount of \$81,346.92, Payroll (VO#32) of 02-07-18 in the amount of \$80.14, and Accounts Payable (VO#33) of 02-08-18 in the amount of \$85,204.34, for total expenditures of \$360,362.91 be approved. There was discussion.

Roll call vote: Ayes: Eldred, Lamoreaux, Frazier, Lyons, Maxwell; Nays: None. Motion carried.

Engineer-Manager Ballou reported that staff had reviewed the bids for the removal and installation of an in-ground hoist and recommended the Board approve the bid of American Hoist, Air & Lube for a total of \$118,515. There was discussion

Moved by Lyons, second by Lamoreaux that the bid for the removal and replacement of an in-ground hoist be awarded to American Hoist, Air & Lube, at a total cost of \$118,515. Motion carried.

Mr. Ballou recommended the Board adopt a resolution accepting the streets of Wind Trace No. 1 into the County road system, noting that the final plat was previously approved.

Moved by Lamoreaux, second by Maxwell to adopt the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Statutes of the State of Michigan require all roads and streets eligible to become a part of the County Road System to be formally accepted by resolution of said Board; and,

WHEREAS, the Michigan Department of Transportation by virtue of Act 51 of the Public Acts of 1951, as amended, requires proof of the acceptance of all roads subsequent to April 1, 1951, by said Board; and,

WHEREAS, certain roads have been constructed or improved to meet the specifications and requirements of the Eaton County Board of Road Commissioners and have been approved by said Board; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Eaton County Board of Road Commissioners, that the following roads be adopted into the Local Road System of the County of Eaton and thereby become eligible for funds from the Michigan Transportation Fund as specified in Act 51 of the Public Acts of 1951, as amended and supplemented:

<u>Traverse Drive</u>, located in the plat of Wind Trace No. 1, for a distance of 968 feet, Section 18, Delta Township; and,

<u>Windswept Drive</u>, located in the plat of Wind Trace No. 1, for a distance of 150 feet, Section 18, Delta Township; and

<u>Windford Lane</u>, located in the plat of Wind Trace No. 1, for a distance of 137 feet, Section 18, Delta Township; and

<u>Mulderstraat Drive</u>, located in the plat of Wind Trace No. 1, for a distance of 234 feet, Section 18, Delta Township.

Roll call vote: Ayes: Eldred, Lamoreaux, Frazier, Lyons, Maxwell; Nays: None. Motion carried.

There was discussion regarding the annual meeting with the townships. The Board scheduled the meeting for Monday, March 26, 2018 at 7:00 pm by consensus.

Mr. Ballou and Finance Director Friedlis reviewed the recent valuation of the Eaton County Road Commission Retiree Medical Plan. There was discussion.

Mr. Ballou opened and read aloud the bids for asphalt emulsion.
