Bill Tucker, Principal, with Maner Costerisan presented the results of the independent financial statement audit for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, noting that the statements received a clean, unmodified opinion.

Assistant County Engineer Hannahs presented the annual road certification maps, and recommended the Board approve the maps and authorize the Chair to sign them. There was discussion.

Moved by Lamoreaux, second by Lyons to approve the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED, that all of the roads on which lengths have been entered along the road bands of the attached township and enlarged section maps dated December 31, 2018 are normally open to automobile traffic during the months of May through October and under the jurisdiction of the Eaton County Road Commission; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chair, namely Jerry L. Frazier, is authorized to sign the certification maps.

Mr. Hannahs reviewed proposals received for the biennial bridge inspections and recommended the Board select OHM Advisors. There was discussion.

Moved by Lyons, second by Eldred that the proposal of OHM Advisors for the biennial bridge inspections be selected. Motion carried.

Mr. Ballou reported on the status of road projects. There was discussion.

Mr. Ballou reported on the activities of the road crews. There was discussion.

Mr. Ballou requested approval to hire one returning engineering co-op student at the rate of \$17.00 per hour. There was discussion.

Moved by Eldred, second by Lyons to hire one returning engineering co-op student at a wage rate of \$17.00 per hour as recommended by staff. Motion carried.

Mr. Ballou reported that the Road Commission received a petition from the Faith Assembly of God requesting the abandonment of the curve on Cochran Road at Baseline Hwy, noting that staff was in the process of verifying the signatures. There was discussion.

There was no public comment.

Chair Frazier adjourned the meeting at 10:10 am without objection.
