

EATON COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION

July 14, 2026

The meeting was called to order by Chair Eldred at 8:30 a.m.

The Chair inquired whether there were any additions or deletions to the agenda. There were none. Motion by Lamoreaux and seconded by Bott to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

The Chair asked if the minutes of the June 23, 2026, meeting were correct as presented. Motion by Lamoreaux and seconded by Bott to approve June 23, 2026, minutes as presented. Motion carried.

Motion by Green and seconded by Lamoreaux to approve Vouchers 53, 54, 55 and 56 with total expenditures of \$1,712,894.49. Roll call vote: Ayes: Eldred, Green, Bott, Kendall and Lamoreaux; Nays: None; Absent: None Motion carried.

The Board reviewed and discussed the remote work policy as presented by the Engineer-Manager with a recommendation that the Board adopt the policy. Motion by Lamoreaux and second by Bott to adopt 2026-01 Remote Work Policy. Roll call vote: Ayes: Eldred, Green, Bott, Kendall and Lamoreaux; Nays: None; Absent: None Motion carried.

The Board reviewed and discussed the Bismark Hwy over the Dooling Drain Culvert Replacement bids as presented by the Engineer/Manager with a recommendation that the bid be awarded to the low bidder, C&H Underground. Motion by Green and second by Kendall to award the Bismark Hwy over the Dooling Drain Culvert Replacement to C&H Underground, being the low bidder. Motion carried.

Old Business: Consider adopting Ena Drive into the public system remains under old business. The Engineer-Manager provided an update on the status of this old business. The only outstanding item appears to be the right of way deed needs to be recorded.

The Superintendent updated the Board on the following:

- The new motor grader has been delivered.
- Chipseal is completed today, waiting on Kathleen Lane approval.
- Fog seal should be completed by next week, weather permitting.
- Over band crack seal has continued.

- Brush mowing for regravels.
- Regravel has continued with both contractors.
- Culvert install on Nashville Hwy is scheduled to start next week.
- Dust control is scheduled to start on the 27th of July.
- Brush/Vegetation Spray program is scheduled to start this weekend.

The Engineer-Manager updated the Board on the following activities:

- Nixon Rd, Davis Hwy to Mt Hope Hwy- paving of leveling course is scheduled to take place this weekend. Top course is scheduled for next week with shoulder gravel to follow.
- Five Pt Hwy, Battle Creek River to Mauer Rd – Road is open to traffic and working on final project documents.
- Five Pt Hwy, Creepy Swamp- ECRC & Consultant have submitted the final bidding documents. EGLE is in the process of submitting the signed permit.
- Bellevue Hwy, Brookfield Rd to Thuma Rd- Project has been awarded to Rieth-Riley. We are working on scheduling a pre-con meeting.
- Holt Hwy, Dimondale Village Limits to Waverly – We are working with our consultant to make changes to the plans and prepare for rebidding.
- Webster Rd Bridge – Contractor is finishing up bridge deck pours and beginning to work on approaches. Bridge is still on track to open to traffic at the end of July.
- Nashville Hwy Culvert-ECRC crews are preparing the area for culvert installation in the coming weeks.
- Engineering staff are working on inspection on re-gravel and gathering traffic count data and culvert collection data.
- Will be doing a millage presentation at the township meetings in August and September.
